

STATE OF ILLINOIS VEHICLE INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

RACE CAR/SHOW CAR AFFIDAVIT QUALIFICATIONS/INSTRUCTIONS

QUALIFICATIONS:

To receive an exemption, as a show/race car, the vehicle referenced above must qualify under the following guidelines in the 625 ILCS 5/13B-15(f)(9).

"Vehicles operated **exclusively** in organized amateur or professional sporting activities..."

"Sporting activities" are those which are business, education, charity or entertainment for the general public. This includes sporting events of schools, governmental entities and professional sports clubs offering exhibitions to the public.

INSTRUCTIONS:

If you feel your vehicle meets this criteria, you must provide this Agency a copy of the vehicle's insurance policy endorsement or declaration page which indicates the use of this vehicle is restricted to show/race events. This documentation is required to substantiate your claim for exemption under the above quoted section of the law.

Please complete the affidavit on the following page and return it along with the required documentation.

Please be advised that this information must be submitted every two years in response to your Vehicle Emissions Test Notice in order for your vehicle to retain the exemption.

For Show cars the insurance policy must clearly indicate that the vehicle's use is restricted to going to and from events. We do not accept letters from insurance agents. We must have a copy of the policy or restricted use endorsement.

If your vehicle is over 25 model years old, you may wish to purchase antique license plates. Vehicles with antique license plates are exempt from emissions inspection. The restrictions on antique vehicle use are the same as those for show cars.

If you have a race car submit pictures, which clearly indicate it is not intended for street use.
